CEMETERY BYELAWS

Byelaws made by the Newark and Sherwood District Council under Section 214 of, and Paragraph 11 of Schedule 26 to, the Local Government Act 1972.

EXTENT

 These byelaws apply to the Lowdham Cemetery, Lowdham, Nottinghamshire.

INTERPRETATION

2. In these byelaws "the Council" means the Newark and Sherwood District Council.

DOGS IN THE CEMETERY

3. No person in charge of a dog shall bring such dog into, or permit such dog to be brought into or remain in, the cemetery:

Provided that this byelaw shall not apply to a blind person in respect of any dog accompanying him.

- 4. Notice of the effect of these byelaws shall be given by signs displayed in conspicuous positions at the entrance to the cemetery.
- 5. An Officer of the Council or any Constable may require a person in charge of a dog which has entered the cemetery to remove the dog from the cemetery.
- 6. For the purpose of byelaw 3 above the keeper of the dog shall be deemed in charge thereof, unless the Court is satisfied that at the time when the dog entered or remained in the cemetery it had been placed or taken into the charge of some other person.
- 7. In byelaw 6 above "the keeper" shall include the owner of the dog or any person who habitually has it in his possession.

PENALTY
