MINUTES OF THE MEETING

Public Participation: Mrs Spolton advised that their property would be having the drive resurfaced on 20 May 2019 and the work would take a number of days. She was seeking advice on possible parking for 2 vehicles rather than cause possible vehicle obstruction close to the A616 junction with Ossington Road.

Minutes of the Previous Meeting – 15 January 2019 – were **Approved** **R Taylor/T Kirk**

Matters Arising from the Minutes:

- 1. Dog Poo Bin** – The additional bin together with 2 posts for it and the re-siting of the Baulk Lane bin were at the Clerk residence. Notts CC/VIA were proving to be somewhat difficult to satisfy as regards possible re-siting.
- 2. Defibrillator** – Purchased by Kneesall School. The Parish Council's contribution is expected to be approximately £500
- 3. Neighbourhood Plan** – It was questioned whether one is actually needed however, it was felt that there should be co-operation between Thoresby Estates/Kneesall Estate (Nick Brown). Volunteers required to assist. Cllrs. Kirk and Allebon will assist but not lead the project although Nick Brown has not contacted the Council following his presentation at the last meeting.
- 4. Local Improvement Scheme (Capital Fund Application)** – Cllr. Lissaman had completed and submitted the application for funding and the decision will be known in May. If used for road signs the Parish Council will be responsible for any maintenance and repairs. It may be necessary to undertake a traffic census on the A616 as part of the application. The council will also have to provide proof of insurance. There had been thoughts of submitting an application for funding to assist with the purchase of swings at the children's play park but retrospective applications are not accepted.
- 5. First Aid Courses** – Cllr. Taylor confirmed that he had made enquires and that at least one course could be arranged and would include information about the use of a defibrillator.
- 6. A616 Approach Signs to Ompton** – Cllr. Davies advised that the missing "beware of Horses" sign had been replaced.
