Planning: Permission to fell a diseased tree at Green Farm Cottage

County Councillor B Laughton – Advised that £18m is to be spent on upgrading the A614 and will include work at the Ollerton roundabout.

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Community Infrastructure Levy (CIL):

- Is a charge on development & came into force in 2010
- Not a compulsory levy but is usually collected by the local Planning Authority
- The rate is set by the Authority after consulting with communities & developers
- PC share is "Neighbourhood Proportion"
- Any amount received is dependent on whether a Neighbourhood Plan has been adopted & in place
- No Neighbourhood Plan – 15% (capped at £100 per Council Tax dwelling the Council's area)
- Adopted Neighbourhood plan in our area (or a development has been granted by a Neighbourhood Plan Development Order) 25% of CIL receipts (uncapped)
- CIL monies can be spent on – infrastructure which includes physical, social & green structures – e.g. highways, cycleways, education facilities, sports & community halls, parks & play areas.
- The monies should be spent within 5 years of receipt if not they can be re-claimed
- Reports must be submitted each financial year

Art Development Programmes:

Local Elections: Kneesall, Kersall & Ompton Councillors had been re-elected unopposed but there are currently 2 vacancies – 1 for Kersall & 1 for Ompton.

Other Matters:

Cllr. C Cutts – 1. Rubbish being left for November Bonfire. Reminder to be issued that "stuff" for the bonfire cannot be collected on site until October.

2. A "No Parking Sign" still required for outside Community Centre/St Bartholomew's
