Planning 16/00312/FUL – Demolition of conservatory and construction of two storey rear extension and internal alterations at Highfields, Central Avenue. After looking over the plans the Council decided to just make observations rather than supporting or objecting the application. Their observations were that they felt there was a potential to over develop the plot due to the size of the proposed extension. They also felt that there could be a detrimental impact on the adjoining property as it block light to the adjoining property and spoil the enjoyment of their amenity.

The waste bin emptying contract for the coming year had been received from N&SDC, it was unanimously agreed at a cost of £334.36 for the year.

Standing Orders were suspended for attending members of the public to comment.

District Councillor Staples reported that he had attended the planning committee meeting at N&SDC which included the planning application for Oakham Farm, Walesby. The planning permission had been granted. It had been a close with the chairman of the committee having the casting vote. It was decided that in the next newsletter details of how to register sound nuisance with N&SDC should be included, along with how to report fly tipping, pot holes and poor pavements.

Standing Orders were resumed.
