What is Best Bar None?

Best Bar None is a nationally recognised scheme that was launched in 2003. It is run in over 100 towns and cities across the UK and is also being rolled out internationally. It is supported by the Home Office.

It is an awards and accreditation scheme for licensed premises that recognises and rewards responsible retailers. Through this it aims to support venues in raising their operating standards and promote venues to the public where they can enjoy a safe time.

Nottinghamshire Best Bar None is open to all pubs, bars, clubs and sports clubs in the county (excluding the city council area), and has been funded by the Police and Crime Commissioner for Nottinghamshire, and Nottinghamshire County Council.

How does it work?

Venues are assessed on their policies and procedures by an external assessor. Everyone who meets all of the essential criteria becomes accredited, with bronze, silver and gold levels of accreditation depending on your score. The highest scoring venues are also put through to a set of awards decided by independent judges.

In addition all accredited venues are entered into a set of awards that are voted for by the public. Winners of both sets of awards will be announced at an awards dinner, with tickets available to all participants.

What's in it for me?

- It helps you check you have the correct procedures and policies in place, and improve your standards
- It promotes your venue you will be featured on the Nottinghamshire Best Bar None website, there will be press coverage around the scheme, there will be a voting campaign which is promoted to the public, and there will be other marketing literature distributed around the county.
- It improves relationships with the police and licensing teams
- Your venue will be recognised as a safe and responsible
- It promotes a responsible side to an industry which is often dogged by blame and bad press
- It can reduce your public health liability insurance

How do I get involved?
