NOTICE OF Full VARIATION to the PREMISES LICENCE APPLICATION RECEIVED BY NEWARK AND SHERWOOD DISTRICT COUNCIL

The proposed use/variation is:

To change the layout and design of the premises in accordance with the submitted plan, drawing number 3549-207. The main changes include the addition of a licensed functions room and reconfiguration of fixed seating. To add the following conditions:

- All staff who have direct dealings with customers shall be trained in the following: (i) Licensing law and in particular that relating to the sale of alcohol; (ii) The Challenge 25 policy; (iii) The premises licence and its conditions. - An incident log will be kept and maintained at the premises and all incidents shall be recorded in it. As a minimum, the log will record the date and time of the incident, the name of the person making the entry, the nature of the incident and any actions taken. - The DPS/manager will undertake a weekly inspection of the public areas of the premises to identify anything might present an identifiable risk to public safety. Any risks identified that are deemed to be unreasonable must be rectified at the earliest possible opportunity. - A Challenge 25 policy shall operate in the premises in relation to the sale of alcohol. The hours and licensable activities authorised by the premises licence are to remain unaltered. Any part of the variation application that changes the plan/layout at the premises to be of no effect until the work has been completed. Locations of fire safety equipment subject to change in accordance with the requirements of the responsible authorities or following a risk assessment. Any detail shown on the plan that is not required by the licensing plan regulations is indicative only and subject to change
