



NOTICE OF PUBLIC PATH ORDER

TOWN AND COUNTRY PLANNING ACT 1990, SECTION 257

NEWARK AND SHERWOOD DISTRICT COUNCIL

DIVERSION OF HAWTON FOOTPATH NO 5 ORDER 2026

The above Order, made on 14 April 2026, under section 257 of the Town and County Planning Act 1990, will divert the public right of way. The effect of the diversion is to provide a new section of path on a grassed surface commencing from a point mark A , SK 7901 5035 and proceeding in a north-easterly direction to a point marked B, SK 7914 5060 , then continuing in a north-westerly direction to a point marked C SK 7900 5072, then continuing in a northern direction to a point marked D, SK 7901 5080, then continuing in a westerly direction to a point parked E SK 7887 5083 and having a total length of approximately 694 metres and a width of 2 metres throughout , as shown on the plan.

If no such representations or objections are duly made, or if any so made are withdrawn, the Newark and Sherwood District Council may themselves confirm the Order as an unopposed Order. If the Order is submitted to the Secretary of State for Housing Communities and Local Government for confirmation any representations and objections which have not been withdrawn will be sent with it.
