## FERNWOOD DIVERSION OF FOOTPATH 1 ORDER (NO.2) 2025

On 25 November 2025 Newark & Sherwood District Council confirmed the above order.

The effect of the Order is to provide a new section of footpath on a tarmac surface with a width of 2 metres commencing from a point marked E, SK 8264 5109 at the junction with the remainder of Fernwood Footpath 1, and proceeding for a distance of approximately 95 metres in a generally west-north-westerly to north-easterly direction to a point marked C, SK 8261 5115 at the junction with the remainder of the Fernwood Footpath 1, as shown on the plan.

If any person aggrieved by the order desires to question its validity or that of any provision contained in it on the ground that it is not within the powers of the Act, or on the ground that any requirement of that Act or any regulations made under it has not been complied with in relation to the confirmation of the order, he or she may apply to the High Court for any of these purposes under section 287 of the Town and Country Planning Act 1990 within 6 weeks from the date on which notice is first published as required by paragraph 7 of the Schedule 14 of that Act.
