

**NOTICE OF CONFIRMATION OF PUBLIC PATH ORDER
TOWN AND COUNTRY PLANNING ACT 1990, SECTION 257
NEWARK AND SHERWOOD DISTRICT COUNCIL
MIDDLEBECK DIVERSION OF HAWTON BRIDLEWAY NO.1 ORDER**

On 26th January 2023 Newark and Sherwood District Council confirmed the above order. The effect of the diversion is to provide a new section of path on a bound gravel surface with a width of 3.7 metres commencing from a point marked SK 7955 5179 at the junction with the remainder of Hawton Bridleway 1 and proceeding for a distance of approximately 120 metres in a generally east-north-easterly and finally north-north-easterly direction to a point marked SK 7963 5187 on the highway known as Grange Road as shown on the attached plan. This order comes into force on the date which Newark and Sherwood District Council confirm that the terms of Article 2 of the Order have been complied with but if any person aggrieved by the order desires to question its validity or that of any provision contained in it on the ground that it is not within the powers of the above Act, or on the ground that any requirement of that Act or any regulation made under it has not been complied with in relation to the confirmation of the order, he or she may apply to the High Court for any of these purposes under section 287 of the Town and Country Planning Act 1990 within 6 weeks from the date the order was confirmed as required by paragraph 7 of Schedule 14 to that Act.
