



**Statement of Fact Notice:
The Publication Amended Allocations & Development Management DPD
Documents are Available for Inspection**

Regulation 19: The Town and Country Planning (Local Planning (England) Regulations 2012

Newark and Sherwood District Council has prepared its Publication Amended Allocations and Development Management DPD, which it proposes to submit to the Secretary of State (Under Regulation 22 of the Town and Country Planning (Local Planning) (England) Regulations 2012 so it can be assessed by an appointed Planning Inspector via an Examination in Public. Prior to submission, the DPD documents are being made available for public inspection at locations across Newark and Sherwood District, providing any individual or group of individuals the opportunity to make a 'Statement of Representation' for consideration by the Independent Planning Inspector.

The 7 week period of public consultation will commence on **Monday 14th November 2022 and end at 5pm on Friday 30th December 2022.** Representations received after this date will not be accepted.

This Statement of Fact Notice outlines the consultation documents which are available for inspection, the subject matter of these documents, and the locations and times at which these documents can be inspected. Subject Matter

The Newark and Sherwood Publication Amended Allocations & Development Management DPD sets out the District Council's location and extent of allocated land and has been written in accordance with the adopted Amended Core Strategy and its approach to settlement growth. It also includes a suite of Development Management policies to provide greater direction, help deliver specific allocations and assist in the day-to-day assessment of planning applications. When adopted it will replace the current Allocations & Development Management DPD which was adopted in 2013. It has been published for a period of public representation before submission to the Secretary of State. The **Policies Map Amendments** sets out the areas where amendments to the Allocations & Development Management DPD have required amendments to the Policies Map. The Policies Map sets out where the specific Development Plan Policies and land designations apply from the Development Plan.

The **Statement of Consultation** sets out a summary of comments received at previous consultations and how these have been taken into account during preparation of the DPD. The **Integrated Impact Assessment** weighs up the social, environmental, health and economic effects of the DPD as well as considering equality issues. The **Habitat Regulations Assessment** assesses the impact of the plan proposals on the most valuable protected habitats in and around the district. A broad range of **Supporting Evidence Base Documents** have been produced to provide evidence to inform the Newark and Sherwood Amended Allocations & Development Management DPD.
