

Notice of Review - Polling Districts and Polling Places

Pursuant to Section 18 of the Representation of the People Act 1983, Newark & Sherwood District Council gives notice that it is to conduct a review of the polling districts and polling places used for elections in the District.

Submissions on any aspect of polling districts and polling places are welcome from any elector within the District, any local constituency political party or any person or group who have a particular expertise in access to premises for persons with any type of disability.
