<b>plastic drink bottles</b>	Can be reused as bird feeders.	<b>plastic bags</b>	Reuse these as shopping bags if clean.
<b>margarine tubs</b>	Can be reused as storage containers or for craft activities.	<b>glue sticks</b>	Can be recycled through paid TerraCycle schemes. Reusable glue sticks are available.
<b>magazines &amp; catalogues</b>	Can be reused as wrapping paper.	<b>packets &amp; wrappers</b>	Some can be recycled as soft plastics at supermarkets.
<b>newspapers</b>		<b>food waste &amp; vegetable peelings</b>	Vegetable and fruit peelings could be composted in an at-home compost bin.
<b>plastic cleaning &amp; soap bottles</b>	Can be reused for craft activities.	<b>food &amp; drink cartons</b>	Can be recycled at the Household Waste & Recycling Centre.
<b>yoghurt pots</b>		<b>toys</b>	Can be donated to a charity shop if in good condition.
<b>cardboard boxes &amp; tubes</b>		<b>paper towels &amp; wet wipes</b>	Towels not containing chemicals can be composted.
<b>food tins</b>		<b>tissues</b>	Tissues not containing chemicals can be composted.
<b>clean cardboard food packaging</b>		<b>laminated paper</b>	Coated in a non-recyclable plastic.
<b>drink cans</b>		<b>glitter or foil on paper/ card</b>	You can pull off these to recycle the paper.
<b>paper &amp; card</b>		<b>takeaway packaging</b>	Contaminated with food
<b>empty aerosol cans</b>	Including hairspray and deodorant bottles.	<b>takeaway cups</b>	Contaminated with liquids
<b>envelopes &amp; junk mail</b>		<b>stationery</b>	Plastic stationery can be recycled through TerraCycle schemes.

		<b>plastic tubes</b>	Can be taken to some high street pharmacies for recycling.

<b>aftershave bottles</b>		<b>reading glasses</b>	most opticians have recycling boxes
<b>reed diffuser bottles</b>	Can be reused with refill home fragrance	<b>panes of window glass</b>	boxes
<b>glass drink, oil and sauce bottles</b>	Can be reused as vases, bird feeders	<b>mirrors</b>	donate to a charity shop if in good condition
