Dear Residents,

The Council has secured Government funding to produce regeneration proposals to improve the Yorke Drive Estate and the Lincoln Road Playing Fields. Regeneration experts Campbell Tickell are helping the Council draw up plans and ensuring we consult effectively with residents.

Thank you for taking part in the Council's recent household survey. The information you provided has helped us to understand how residents feel about their homes and the neighbourhood.

Over 60% of residents participated in the survey, which will be used to help shape the Council's approach toward producing development proposals for the area.

HOUSEHOLD SURVEY RESULTS

Over 60% of residents participated in the survey, which will be used to help shape the Council's approach toward producing development proposals for the area.

The survey was carried out through going door to door and inviting residents to drop ins over four weeks in February/March.

You told us you LIKE the following about your home:



- Good neighbours / strong community
- Location on estate
- Generous size of home and/or garden

You told us what you LIKE about your neighbourhood:

- · Quiet depending on location
- Close community, Yorke Drive Life events, proximity to family, good neighbours
- Location close to town, convenient for work, local shops and schools

You told us what you DON'T LIKE about your home:



- Repairs: perception of damp/mould growth,
- Difficulty getting repairs appointments particularly for shift workers.
- ASB (anti-social behaviour): from youths or neighbours (untidy gardens, noise or aggression, drug-dealing)
- Size of home (too small)


You told us what you **DON'T LIKE** about the neighbourhood:

- ASB / youths taunting vulnerable people, damaging vehicles, drugs, litter
- Speeding traffic, mopeds on playing field
- Neighbours who don't look after property, bulky rubbish in some gardens, damaged fencing not repaired, unruly children





We asked if you would support building new homes on part of the Lincoln Road Playing Fields:



Of residents completing the survey:

- 48% said they already regularly use or have recently used the playing fields
- 5% said they participate in organised sports on the plaving fields
- 51% said they would use improved facilities

You told us to keep you informed through regular newsletters, exhibitions and drop-ins.

Yorke Drive Project: Masterplanning Resident Consultation Spring/Summer 2018

The Council will be holding a series of exhibitions, workshops and events over the summer for residents to contribute their ideas and help produce improvement proposals for the estate and the Lincoln Road Playing Fields.

There will be design workshops for residents with the Councils architects HTA on 23rd May and 27th June leading up to a first Public Exhibition of Masterplan Options for the area in mid-July.

The Council is aiming to produce masterplan proposals for the area by

September 2018, and if these attract residents' support, the Council will take this forward in the form of an outline planning application for the proposals before the end of the year.
