The Resident Panel represents the views of residents across the estate as part of the regeneration project. Chaired by a resident, the panel follows a code of conduct and terms of reference that all members agree on.

#### Complete our survey

We want the Yorke Drive regeneration scheme to have a genuinely positive impact for everyone who currently lives on the estate. To help us measure the level of impact the project will have upon the community, we will be running a survey to better understand how you feel about certain things on the estate, such as safety, wellbeing and how you get along with your neighbours.

We will then run the survey again throughout the redevelopment work so we can understand the changes taking place and how you feel about them. It's really important that we capture your views now and hope as many of you as possible will spare 5 minutes to complete it.
